WHAT IS THE MENTORING CENTER?

The CJ mentoring center allows undergraduate students to **connect with graduate students** in Temple's Criminal Justice department.

CJ mentoring services include both assistance with **coursework** (e.g., help with assignments, study and reading tips) **and professional development** (e.g., graduate school advice, help with resumes).

We offer both **in person and virtual meetings**, dependent on your preferences and needs!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Fill out the **Google Form** (linked below), indicating what you would like assistance with and when you can meet.
2. A **graduate student will be paired with you**, depending on their expertise and ability to assist you, within 24-48 hours.
3. You will **receive an email** from the graduate student that you've been paired with, and you two will **schedule a time to meet**.
