The Tsushima Effect

I completed extensive primary and secondary source research on the Imperial Japanese Navy to argue that the Battle of Tsushima in 1905, near the conclusion of the Russo-Japanese War, created lasting doctrinal and strategic effects that eventually would cause the IJN defeat at the Battle of Midway in 1942. These effects included a general superiority complex for IJN leadership that impacted Japanese negotiations at the Washington and London Naval Conferences that, in the eyes of the Japanese, unfairly restricted Japanese naval expansion. The victory over the Russian Navy in 1905 also served as the prime example of naval combat that IJN leaders would always seek to recreate the engagement circumstances for. The need to develop a “Tsushima scenario” for a single fleet-on-fleet on engagement to create a decisive victory drove all aspects of IJN doctrine and strategy from technological acquisition and shipbuilding, to war planning and tactical actions. The “Tsushima Effect” culminated in the IJN plan to force the U.S. Navy into a “Tsushima scenario” in 1942 near the island of Midway.
