RESEARCH INTEREST

I explore various areas of Spanish applied linguistics and sociolinguistics. I am particularly interested in foreign language teaching and second language acquisition. Using text and other media (video, ICTs, etc.) to explore different teaching methods from a cognitive and pedagogical point of view inspired my bachelor's thesis, which shows how literary works and their adaptations can be used in the language classroom, and my master's thesis, which presents a study on adopting a flipped classroom approach to introduce new text types. Currently, I am working on a collaborative project between Temple University and Salzburg University, which is concerned with enhancing students' environmental awareness by including comics in the Elementary Spanish classrooms. In collaboration with my colleague Bako Bapio Pierre, I am working on a sociolinguistic research project investigating gender-inclusive language practices and perceptions among graduate teaching assistants of Spanish.
